

# TENNIS AND PICKLEBALLCON in used



Hello fellow picklers, this is the first in what we hope is a monthly information/instruction column about Pickleball at Oak Village. We are a fairly active group of about 30 members, and we play this crazy game called Pickleball. For those unfamiliar, it is a game that is played on a lined court 44 feet long by 20 feet wide. It has a NVZ- no volley zone - that is 7 feet on either side of the net. This area is referred to as the kitchen. (more about all of this in future months). Pickleball is played with a paddle a little larger than a ping pong paddle and a plastic ball with 40 holes in it similar to a wiffle ball. There you have it, now you too can join us and learn this highly addictive game.

# At Oak Village, we have 4 dedicated pickleball courts with temporary nets and 1 overflow court.

That means up to 20 people can play at any one time. We have play on the courts almost every day. Beginner players and those wanting to learn the game play Monday, Wednesday and Friday from about 7-9 am. Established players play Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday from 7:30 till everyone goes home. Beginners are also welcome to come those days, just a little higher level of play. Wednesday evening also has some play time after 3:30pm.



## Club members are also in an experimental county wide league that just started last week. In

this league a group of us travel to different pickleball venues and play against other clubs. The format is 2 men's doubles courts, 2 women's doubles courts and 3-4 mixed doubles courts. Play days vary and so far, everyone has really enjoyed playing.

Well that's about it for this month, I will leave you with this- the first pickle ball language you need to learn is Zero- Zero Start! Come see us at the courts and we will tell you more!




